Black belts must be familiar with all compulsory kata listed, they will be advised which kata to perform in Round 1 by the referee.

Team Kata: all divisions perform their choice of kata from the list for their division.

The highest grade of a team member will determine the category for the team.

Penalties and disqualification:

Categories 1, 2 & 9 (grades up to and including 7th Kyu) will be allowed a restart their kata if they miss the start. This will however be taken into consideration when scoring the kata. The restart will apply to both individual and team kata and only in Round 1. Should a person elect to compete in a higher grade then that category's guidelines will apply.

All other categories will not be allowed a kata restart, and the competitor/team will be disqualified from that event, or scored on what they have demonstrated.

No kata for team or individuals, regardless of grade or division, may be performed twice. Should a kata be performed twice, it will result in a no-score on the second occasion.
